Election 2024 Election Volunteer Terms

Canvass - Efforts by political parties and issue groups to identify supporters, persuade the undecided, register voters and cultivate support

Canvass monitoring - Parties and candidates are permitted to designate authorized representatives to observe the pre-canvass and canvass meetings where mail-in and absentee ballots are counted and

recorded

Poll officer - Individuals that monitor the opening and closing of voting locations and the voting process

Poll watcher - An appointee certified by the county to observe polling places and ensure nobody is doing anything illegal

Reconcilliation - Ensure the number of ballots cast matches the number of voters who participated in the election process

Voter list maintenance - The ongoing process election officials do to maintain accurate voter rolls

Election 2024 Mail-In Voting Terms & Definitions

Ballot harvesting - Illegal collection and delivery of mail-in ballots

Cure period - Time period for voters to update rejected ballots with missing information and ensure the vote is counted

Mail-in ballots - Ballot sent before election day through the mail. Can be returned through the mail or dropped off at the county elections office, satellite office locations or drop box; absentee ballots, those cast by a voter other than in-person on election day are a type of mail-in ballot

Naked ballot - Mail ballot returned without a secrecy envelope

Secretary of the Commonwealth - Chief election officer appointed by the Governor

Statutorily required audit - A statistical recount in a given county of a random sample of at least 2% of the ballots cast or 2,000 ballots, whichever is fewer
